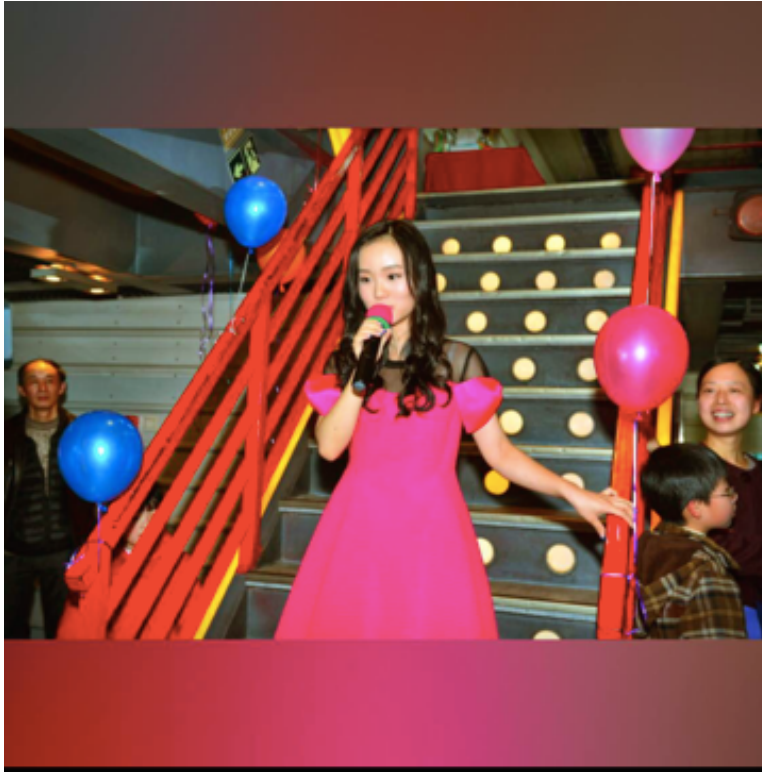


# People
