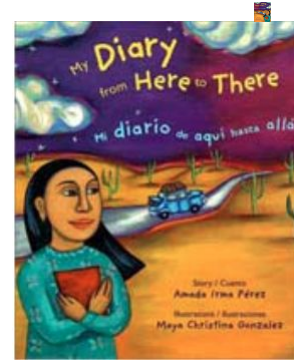

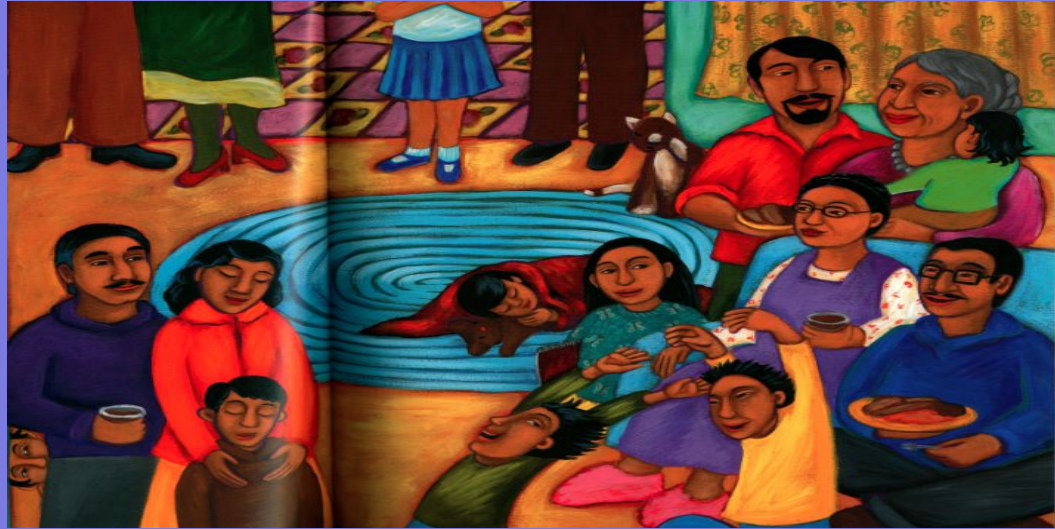
BOOK CULTURE

-bedroom

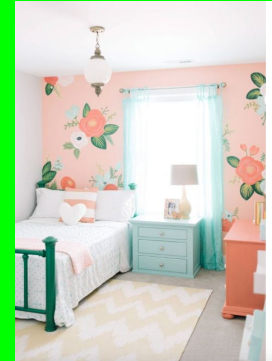
