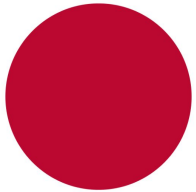

Raiju (warlord)



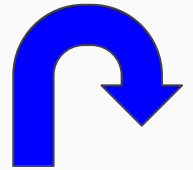
SETTING

NEW VOCABULARY I

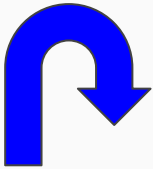
1. **journey**- a traveling from one place to another, usually taking a rather longtime.
